

Club Options to Host National Breed Shows with WCC

1) OPTION A

\$9 per head covers:

Cooping

Judging equipment

Shavings

Set-up/Tear-down of all equipment and cooping

Breed Club Booth (10' X 10')

Choice from our WCC hired judges for the national (does not include additional specialty shows)

Secretary services: receiving entries, processing data, remark cards, show reports, postage...

This OPTION A does not include purchasing ARBA and breed club specialty sanctions for the national show nor awards.

2) OPTION B

\$2 per head covers:

Judging equipment

Choice from our judges for the national (does not include additional specialty shows)

Breed Club Booth (10' X 10')

This OPTION B does not include purchasing ARBA and breed club specialty sanctions for the national show, awards, cooping, shavings, set-up/Tear-down, nor secretary services. You may use our secretary services for an additional \$0.50 per rabbit which include receiving entries, processing data, remark cards, show reports, postage...

3) OPTION C

\$1 per head covers:

Judging equipment

Breed Club Booth (10' X 10')

This OPTION C does not include purchasing ARBA and breed club specialty sanctions for the national show, awards, a JUDGE, cooping, shavings, set-up/Tear-down, nor secretary services. This option requires you to bid, book, house, feed and pay your own judge. You may use our secretary services for an additional \$0.40 per rabbit which include receiving entries, processing data, remark cards, show reports, postage...

4) ADDITIONAL SPECIALTY SHOWS:

Additional specialty shows operate a lot like OPTION B or C for the national shows (same fees). For OPTION B, you choose one of our judges, you buy your ARBA and breed club specialty sanctions, organize awards... etc... For OPTION C it's the same except that you must hire/pay your own private judge. There is no labor with specialty shows so set-up/tear-down is not a factor. You may use our secretary services for an additional \$0.40 per rabbit which include receiving entries, processing data, remark cards, show reports, postage...

5) COOPING:

If you choose OPTION B or C for the national show, cooping will be an additional fee of around \$2 per coop. Something you might consider is NOT having cooping. For less populous breeds, clubs have opted not to use cooping at all.

Beveren, Angora, Silver, and Palomino are good examples of this. Instead, the rabbits remained in their carriers like a normal show. Note: Provide 1 representative for every 50 rabbits to assist in coop setup. Representative MUST arrive by 12 PM on Thursday prior to the show. Club must also provide 1 representative for every 50 rabbits to assist immediately AFTER the conclusion of the "WCC Perpetual Cup Best of the Best In Show" ceremony on Sunday to assist in the tearing down, cleaning and storage of cooping.

6) SHAVINGS

Shavings are your responsibility unless you choose OPTION A. And, if you do not use cooping at all, shavings are irrelevant.

7) HOST HOTEL

Peppermill will serve as the WCC host hotel with a WCC group rate.

8) CAMPING

We do not have any contracts with camping facilities

9) SANCTIONING

Regardless of what option you choose, any breed national or breed specialty show must: 1) Purchase an ARBA specialty show sanction from the ARBA at least 30 days prior to the judging date, 2) Purchase a breed club sanction from their national breed club at least 30 days prior to the judging date
